

Heuglin's Lodge

Situation

On the edge of Lilongwe in the outer reaches of the northern suburbs about 20 mins drive from the airport.

Heuglin's Lodge which is named after the brightly coloured Heuglin's Robin found in the gardens, is run by Wilderness Safaris. It's a lovely big house which has been converted into a guest lodge set in large gardens in the leafy northern suburbs of Lilongwe, Malawi's capital city.

There are six bedrooms, most of which have en-suite bathrooms. Two of the bedrooms can be combined to make a family unit. There is a large lounge with a library, bar, TV and internet access.

Excellent chefs produce plentiful home cooked food from local ingredients. Attractive, mature gardens with a good size swimming pool and outside verandah add to the comfort factor and relaxed atmosphere.

This is an ideal start or end to a holiday in Malawi and also a perfect base for looking around the capital or can be used as a day room stop over on the way to the airport.
