

# Pumulani



- Highlights**
- Superb luxury accommodation on the shores of Lake Malawi
  - Beautiful views and elevated position
  - Ideal place to relax after a safari
  - Great freshwater diving and snorkelling
- Situation** Southern Lake Malawi in the national park area. Nearest airstrip 15 mins drive (Monkey Bay), or 3-4 hours road from Lilongwe.
- Activities** Snorkelling, fishing, sailing, nature and village walks, sunset cruises, kayaking, mountain bikes. Extra: scuba diving and motorised water sports (waterskiing, fun tube, picnic tours, Yoga).

Pumulani means 'place of rest', it is the ideal place to relax and unwind after a safari. It is on the west side of the Nankumba Peninsula at the southern end of Lake Malawi. This is the only lodge situated inside the Lake Malawi National Park, an area which is now a World Heritage Site and protects the endangered cichlid fish of the area.

The lodge is on a hillside with lovely views from the rooms. The main building has a dining room, bar and a large deck with views over the lake. There is a horizon swimming pool on a lower terraced deck.

The villa style rooms are huge and are privately separated by rocks and trees. Each of the ten rooms has a bedroom, bathroom and sitting area with raised decks. Luxurious bathrooms contain both showers and baths.

Pumulani has a private beach and a bar on the beach for drinks and light snacks. There are also shady gardens for those wanting to escape the sun!



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
