Jacana Lodge is set on the edge of a crater lake and is designed to blend into the wooded surroundings of the Maramagambo Forest. The lodge is built of natural materials including rock, wood and rope to enhance its natural feel. Each of the log cabins is individually furnished to a high standard and all are ensuite.

The main lodge building and bar are located beside the lake, with the restaurant and lounge set on a higher level. There is also a swimming pool and sun deck where guests can relax. A floating dining area on the lake is a tranquil place to enjoy sundowners and dinner. The lodge is a perfect place from which to explore the national park.

Game viewing nearby on the Mweya Peninsula and boat trips on the Kazinga Channel offer a stunning variety of wildlife. Near to the lodge is the amazing Kyambura Gorge where treks can be taken to see chimpanzees and colobus monkeys, but this is not for the faint-hearted! Even if you don't go into the gorge, the view over the top with the rolling mist rising is magical.

Guests can also enjoy walks in Maramagambo Forest or kayaking on the crater lake.
