

# Chelinda Camp



- Highlights**
- Walking or mountain biking on the Nyika Plateau
  - Fantastic bird watching
  - Unusual mammal species on the Nyika such as Roan Antelope and Eland
  - Amazing views and panoramic vistas
  - Great night drives
- Situation** Nyika National Park, Northern Malawi, access from Mzuzu (180km by road) or fly into the parks airstrip by charter.
- Activities** Walking, mountain biking, game viewing (day and night), birdwatching, fly fishing, relaxing. Horse riding on Nyika Plateau is currently not available.

Chelinda Camp consists of self catering chalets, each with two bedrooms and bathrooms with showers or baths and a lounge and dining room in each chalet with an open log fire and kitchen.

These chalets were originally parks board self catering accommodation and then were substantially upgraded by Nyika Safaris who left the property at the end of 2007. In 2009 Wilderness Safaris took over the management of Chelinda and upgraded the accommodation, though they can still be booked on a self catering basis, we are using them as part of tailor made trips where your staff arrange all the meals for you.

The accommodation is simple but very comfortable with all facilities provided and excellent food. There are experienced staff at the camp who will look after the accommodation, stoke the fires and look after you well!

Visits to Chelinda normally include 2 game drives per day and a walk or an all day trip out with a picnic. The birding here is fantastic and night drives are also usually very productive with plenty of nocturnal wildlife. Mountain biking can also be arranged from Chelinda and fishing on the dam.
