The 72 foot, 14 passenger catamaran Nemo II offers comfortable accommodation and a stable ride. She was built in 1990 and has 7 cabins, 2 of which have double beds. All are fully air conditioned and have ensuite bathroom facilities including a hot shower. The cabins are located in both hulls.

The large salon and dining room span both hulls. There is also a bar serving a full range of soft and alcoholic drinks. Between meals snacks are readily available. There is a large sundeck above the salon with a diving deck. Nemo II carries snorkelling equipment, a sea kayak and a dinghy, free for guests to use.
