Cachalote is a small schooner-rigged motor sailer, built in 2002 and pleasantly furnished. She has an average cruising speed of 9 knots. While cruising, guests are free to relax on any of the three wooden decks and enjoy the sun and fine views. Cachalote has a friendly crew, and a good naturalist guide, to enhance your visit to these wonderful islands. In appropriate conditions the sails may be hoisted, but please note that this happens fairly infrequently.

Cachalote accommodates 16 guests. There are 7 cabins with upper and lower berths and a further double cabin. All have ensuite bathroom with hot shower. They also have individual air conditioning control. The dining room and lounge has panoramic windows, to make the most of the island and ocean views.
